



Weekly schedule 12 Activities and talks for families

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

1. GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- The participant must be a MAIH member in good standing.
- Annual fees are \$20 for individual members and \$25 for a family membership.
- · The member must meet the specific eligibility criteria for each program:
- 18+ years old
- Mild to moderate intellectual disability
- No behavioural issues
- Ability to function in a group (1:4 ratio)
- Independent in daily activities (eating, grooming, etc.)

We reserve the right to review a member's participation in an activity at any time if their behavior does not meet the eligibility criteria.

2. REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- To join the association before registering for an activity, new members must meet with a coordinator for an assessment of their needs.
- For members in good standing, registrations will be taken by phone only during the planned period, according to the above-mentioned eligibility criteria and depending on the places available.

Registration by phone or online does not guarantee confirmation at the workshop. The activity will be confirmed by a coordinator by e-mail or telephone within 2 weeks of registration.

3. PAYMENT METHODS

- We accept payment by credit card, cheque or cash.
- You can pay by phone (credit card), in person at the MAIH (cheque, cash or credit card) or by mail (cheque or cash).
- · Payments must be completed before the start of activities.

4. CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

- If the MAIH is required to cancel the participation of a member who has paid the fee in whole or in part (including the deposit), the member will either be refunded in full within a reasonable timeframe or his or her account will be credited, whichever method is deemed preferable.
- The MAIH reserves the right to cancel the participation of a member at any time if their behaviour or medical condition warrants immediate withdrawal, and without any refund.
- The MAIH reserves the right to cancel any activity without prior notice.
- If a member cancels his or her registration less than 30 days before the activity, he or she will be refunded only if the following two conditions are met: presentation of a valid reason justifying the cessation of participation AND if the MAIH is able to fill the member's place with another member on the waiting list.

5. ADDITIONAL CHARGES

- In the event that a cheque payment is not processed by a banking institution, the MAIH will levy a penalty of up to \$25 to cover administrative costs.
- In the event that a cheque payment is returned for insufficient funds (NSF), the MAIH will levy a penalty of up to \$25 to cover
- Interest will be charged at a rate of 5% per month on all unpaid invoices as of 30 days after the date of the unpaid activity.
- As well, interest will be charged at a rate of 5% per month on all overdue accounts.
